Please remember that term time holiday cannot be authorised by the head teacher – all term time holiday will be classified as unauthorised. Please be aware that term time holiday (10 sessions within a 12 school week period) must be referred to Dorset Local Authority and this could lead to a £60 penalty Notice being issued to each parent for each child who misses school.

Over the next couple of years, one of our school ambitions/aims is to 'make a change' in our own community that will have an impact on the wider world. The school is very keen to ensure that we are recycling as much as possible and the children are doing a fantastic job of collecting their crisp packets after lunch time. All of the crisp packets are being collected and given to the Church who will be sending all the crisp packets collected to a company who make everyday items from the materials recycled.

The Church is also collecting Eco Bricks. Eco Bricks are plastic bottles crammed with plastics that you can't recycle. You need a 1.5l or 2l bottle, fill it with all of your non-recyclable plastics, push them down tightly into the bottle and screw the lid on. The school is very happy to act as a collection point!
