Engaging

Trust is the foundation on which all good friendships are built.

But sometimes we can feel disappointed by our friends. Perhaps they haven't done what they promised they would do, or maybe we thought they would stand by us when life was difficult and they didn't.

People can occasionally be unreliable, but the Psalmist reminds us that God will never disappoint us.

"My God is my strength in whom I trust." Psalm 18.2

God promises are true and we can trust them. They are like a strong, sturdy platform that we can stand on.

In the Bible, God promises:

Do not fear, for I am with you (Isiah 31.41)

I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you (Isiah 41.10)

Give all your worries to me because I care for you (Peter 5.7)

He tells us that when we pray to him, we will be listened to and will receive strength when we are facing hard times. He promises that nothing, absolutely nothing can separate us from his love.
