Outdoor Learning for All

We are delighted to be able to inform you that from September, Mrs Higgs will be leading regular Outdoor Learning for all classes across the school on Monday and Tuesday afternoons. She will be carrying out the training as a Forest School Leader during the Summer holidays and over the next few months so that we have a fully trained person working in our school to provide focussed learning in the wooded areas of our school grounds. The children in Jungle class will have their session on Mondays for the first half term and Woodland on Tuesday afternoons. After half term it will be the turn of Ocean and Desert classes.

All children will need to come into school on their 'Outdoor Learning' days in suitable clothing with long sleeves and trousers, sturdy shoes/ trainers/ wellies and have a set of waterproofs as we will go outside no matter what the weather. You might like to think about getting your child kitted out over the summer holidays. If anyone has any wellies/ outdoor gear that your child has outgrown and you are happy to donate to school, then please leave with the office and we will organise a box in the entrance for anyone who might need additional support with any kit. Please speak to Mrs Higgs / Mrs Adams or Mr Wright if you need support with providing your child with the correct clothing for this activity.

In addition, Mrs Higgs will be running an after-school club on Tuesdays for 10 children each half term from 3.15pm-4.15pm. The first half term will be for children in Ocean and Desert classes and the second half term for those in Woodland or Jungle. There will be a small cost of £3 each week for the club to cover the cost of consumables.

***In September, we will start to organise after school clubs and details will be sent out then telling you how you can sign up your child.**

We are hugely grateful to our PTA for their incredibly generous donation to enable our school to provide this 'Outdoor Learning for All' and to Mr Wright for his fundraising to support it too. Thank you for your continued support with all our PTA fundraising activities. These additionally funded learning opportunities truly enrich our children's learning.

If you get into trouble in the water, Float to Live!

Lifeboats

Tilt your head back with ears submerged

2



Relax and try to control your breathing

3



Move your hands & legs to help you stay a float

4



It's okay if your legs sink, we all float differently

5



Spread your arms and legs to improve stability

FLAGS



(Black/White Flag)

This area is for water-sports like windsurfing and surfing, kayaks & paddleboards.

SIGNS



(SIGN 1)

This sign means do not use inflatables. It's unsafe in strong winds.



(SIGN 2)

This sign means beware of rip currents in this area. They can drag you out of your depth.



(SIGN 3)

This sign means beware of the tide. You could get cut off when the tide



(Red/Yellow Flag)

This is a lifeguarded area. This is the safest area to swim or bodyboard.



(Red Flag)

This means danger. NEVER go into the sea where this flag is flying.



(Orange Flag)

Indicates offshore or strong wind conditions. Never use inflatables when it's flying.
