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Outdoor Learning for All

We are delighted to be able to inform you that from next week, Mrs Higgs will be leading regular Outdoor Learning for all classes across the school on Monday and Tuesday afternoons. She has carried out the training as a Forest School Leader during the Summer holidays and over the next few months so that we have a fully trained person working in our school to provide focussed learning in the wooded areas of our school grounds. A huge thank you to Mrs Higgs for this commitment during the holidays!

The children in Jungle class will have their session on Mondays for the first half term and Woodland on Tuesday afternoons. After half term, it will be the turn of Ocean and Desert classes.

Children will need to come into school on their 'Outdoor Learning' days in suitable clothing with long sleeves and trousers, sturdy shoes/ trainers/ wellies and have a set of waterproofs as we will go outside no matter what the weather. If anyone has any wellies/ outdoor gear that your child has outgrown and you are happy to donate to school, then please leave with the office and we will organise a box in the entrance for anyone who might need additional support with any kit. Please speak to Mrs Higgs / Mrs Adams or Mr Wright if you need support with providing your child with the correct clothing for this activity.

In addition, Mrs Higgs will be running an after school club on Tuesdays for 10 children each half term from 3.15pm-4.15pm. There will be a small cost of £3 each week for the club to cover the cost of consumables.

We are hugely grateful to our PTA for their incredibly generous donation to enable our school to provide this 'Outdoor Learning for All' and to Mr Wright for his fundraising to support it too. Thank you for your continued support with all our PTA fundraising activities. These additionally funded learning opportunities truly enrich our children's learning.

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Flu Vaccinations

Flu is an unpredictable virus that can kill thousands of people during a flu season. The flu vaccine is the best defence we have against it. Vaccination of children is based on the recommendation of the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI), the independent, expert, scientific advisory group that advises the government on vaccination and immunisation. Flu can be a very nasty illness in children and complications include acute bronchitis, painful ear infections, and pneumonia. Some children may need to go to hospital for treatment, including intensive care.

The benefits of vaccination also include reduced transmission of flu in the community. This is because children play a key role in the transmission of flu, including to those who may be at higher risk from the complications of flu such as babies, pregnant women and the elderly.

Since the start of the children's nasal spray vaccine programme, research has shown that vaccinating large numbers of children has reduced the circulation of flu in the community. This has reduced the number of GP consultations for flu-like illness for both the vaccinated children and the wider community and has also reduced hospital admissions from flu.

Benefits to everyone in schools:

For schools the benefits include reduced pupil absence and the reduced likelihood of teachers catching flu from their pupils. In addition, vaccination:

- helps protect children against flu which in turn reduces pupil and staff absenteeism rates
- promotes a healthy environment in schools and the wider community, including amongst the children's immediate and extended family
- reduces the likelihood of flu outbreaks in schools

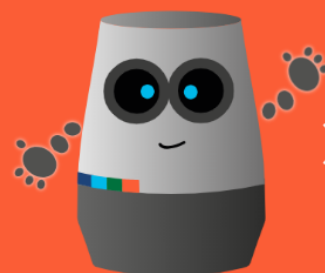
Swiggle.org.uk Child Friendly Search Engine
